This Committee works independently and makes its decisions based on established criteria. Members of the Board of Directors, Officers, the Advisory Board and employees of the Foundation may not serve on the Academic Committee.

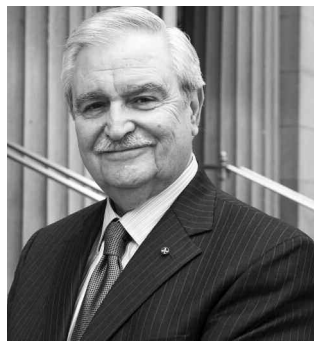

Renée Kleris '04

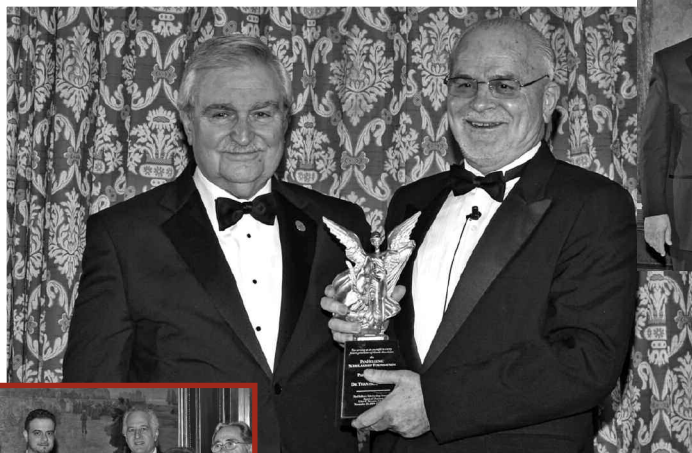
Renee graduated from Emory University in May 2008 and is now a second year medical student at Mercer University School of Medicine in Macon, Georgia.

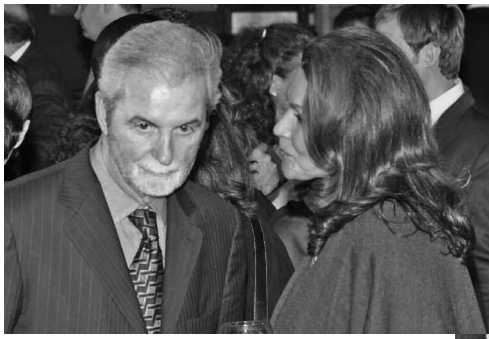
